### BOC: IT Service Management partner of the Vienna International Airport

Nowadays, it is not feasible to operate an airport terminal without applying information and communication technology (ICT). Just like airplanes and terminals, ICT components need to be operated, monitored and maintained.

For day-to-day operations, it is necessary to implement ICT processes such as incident management, change management and operation control. Continuous monitoring of IT services is necessary, e.g., to improve reaction times in case of failure. Service level agreements between different departments of the airport are used to agree upon the quality of the IT services. Maintenance contracts are also used as a type of "reinsurance" for outsourced IT services.

BOC has been supporting the Vienna International Airport with the implementation of the above mentioned operating concepts based on international standards, such as COBIT, ITIL and TOGAF. These concepts ensure high-quality operation of ICT based on current customer requirements and during the further development and expansion of ICT starting with the operation of Check-In 3.
